





**END HUNTING, SHOOTING AND ALL BLOOD SPORTS**

In the UK 700,000 grouse are shot for "sport" each year.

Reasons to ban grouse shooting:

Grouse are sentient beings who wish to live.

In order to have as many grouse as possible to shoot the shooting industry illegally kills birds of prey including Hen Harrier, buzzards, golden eagles and peregrine falcons.

Also killed by traps and snares are mountain hares, foxes, stoats, badgers and birds such as magpies.

Grouse shooting causes environment damage.

It is inhumane to use wild birds as 'living targets' for 'sport'
