Leaving a gift in your will is an incredible way to ensure what's most important to you in your lifetime can live on for many decades to come. How to make your will

Making a will is one of the most important things we can do during our lifetimes. When you make or amend your will, it's important to have a qualified solicitor to take care of it for you. A properly written will makes your intentions clear – and it can protect those close to you from having to deal with complex challenges down the line. That is why we have teamed up with the National Free Wills Network so you can write or amend a simple will for free.

There are many ways you can remember us in your will. You can choose to:

- Leave a percentage of your estate after your other beneficiaries have been provided for. This is known as a **residuary gift**.
- Leave a set amount of money of your choosing. This is known as a **pecuniary gift**.
- Leave an item of value such as property or jewellery. This is known as a **specific gift**.
